That the foregoing amendments shall be reflected in the full classification and 22 pay plan kept and maintained in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, as reflected at Clerk Filing 23 No. 12-312-F, and at the Office of Human Resources, and shall be available for public inspection 24 both in person and on-line.
