Section 1. That sub-sub-subsection b. (Special events) of subsection 10 (Parks permit fee schedule) of section 121 (Schedule for Use of Facilities) of Article IV (Fees and Charges) of Chapter 39 (Parks and Recreation) of the Revised Municipal Code shall be amended by deleting the language and numbers stricken and adding the language and numbers underlined, as follows:

Special events (including festivals, races, walks, and special occasions). The b. manager shall designate which locations within parks subject to permitting fall under the categories in the table below. The duration of time blocks shall be established by the manager of parks and recreation. Fee per time block:
