7 **For an ordinance designating 1475 Elizabeth Street, The Bonfils Memorial**
8 **Theater/Lowenstein Theater, as a structure for preservation.**

10 **WHEREAS**, the Landmark Preservation Commission has transmitted to the Council a proposed
11 designation of a structure for preservation; and

12 **WHEREAS**, 1475 Elizabeth Street, The Bonfils Memorial Theater/Lowenstein Theater, meets the
13 criteria for designation as a structure for preservation as set out in Section 30-3 of the Denver
14 Revised Municipal Code, as amended, by:

15 1. *History*

16 c. *Having a direct and substantial association with a person or group of persons who had*
17 *influence on society*

18 The Bonfils Memorial Theater (now called the Lowenstein Theater) exemplifies the cultural,
19 social and historic heritage of the City of Denver through its association with Helen Bonfils, owner
20 and publisher of the Denver Post, Denver social leader and philanthropist, and actress and leader
21 in Denver civic theater, all of which combined to make her a prominent, powerful and influential
22 woman in Denver. The theater is also closely associated with Henry Lowenstein, the Denver
23 Civic Theater and the general growth of Denver as the theatrical capital of the inter-mountain
24 West.

25 2. *Architecture*

26 a. *Embodying the distinguishing characteristics of an architectural style or type*

27 The Bonfils Memorial Theater/ Lowenstein Theater has the distinguishing characteristics of
28 the Art Moderne architectural style.

29 b. *Being a significant example of the work of a recognized architect or master builder.*

30 The Bonfils Memorial Theater/ Lowenstein Theater was designed by John K. Monroe, a
31 local master architect largely known for his work for the Archdiocese of Denver.

32 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**

1 **DENVER:**

2 **Section 1.** That the certain property commonly called 1475 Elizabeth Street, The Bonfils
3 Memorial Theater/Lowenstein Theater and legally described as follows, together with all
4 improvements situated and located thereon, be and the same is hereby designated as a structure
5 for preservation:

6 Legal Description of Property: A parcel of land located in the Northwest One
7 quarter of Section 1, Township 4 South, Range 68 West of the Sixth Principal
8 Meridian, City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, more particularly
9 described as follows: UNIT 1, LOWENSTEIN CONDOMINIUMS, according to the
10 map thereof, recorded October 11, 2006 under Reception No. 2006162720, City
11 and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

12 **Section 2.** The effect of this designation may enhance the value of said property but may
13 delay or require denial of building permits found unacceptable by the Landmark Preservation
14 Commission under the criteria contained in the Design Guidelines for Historic Structures and
15 Districts, and Section 30-6 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code.

16 **Section 3.** This ordinance shall be recorded among the records of the Clerk and Recorder
17 of the City and County of Denver.
