6 **For an ordinance amending the classification and pay plan for employees in the**
7 **Career Service and for certain employees not in the Career Service.**

9 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to 9.1.1 (C) and (D) of the Charter and Article I of Chapter 18, D.R.M.C.,
10 the Career Service Authority has recommended to the City Council an amendment to the classification
11 and pay plan governing the compensation of employees in the career service and certain employees
12 not in the career service;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**
14 **DENVER:**

15 **Section 1.** That effective **November 21, 2010**, the classification and pay plan is hereby
16 amended by deleting the following job titles and associated pay grades, to read as follows:
