A BILL

For an ordinance relinquishing the easement reserved in Ordinance No. 224, Series of 2014, bounded by 36th Street, Blake Street, Walnut Street and Downing Street.

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of Public Works of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity no longer requires the easement in the area hereinafter described, and subject to approval by ordinance, has relinquished the same;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Executive Director of Public Works in relinquishing the easement reserved in Ordinance No. 224, Series of 2014 in the following area:

A TRACT OF LAND, BEING THE 16 FOOT WIDE ALLEY VACATED BY ORDINANCE 224, SERIES OF 2014, RECORDED AT RECEPTION NO. 2014046693 WITHIN BALDWIN'S ADDITION TO DENVER, LYING SOUTHEAST OF BLAKE STREET, NORTHEAST OF 36TH STREET, NORTHWEST OF WALNUT STREET AND SOUTHWEST OF DOWNING STREET, SITUATED IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 23, AND THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 68 WEST OF THE SIXTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER, STATE OF COLORADO.
