A resolution authorizing expenditures in the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the Office of National Drug Control Policy to award funding for the “High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (H.I.D.T.A) FY17” program.

WHEREAS, the United States Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) awards H.I.D.T.A grant funds to the City and County of Denver annually; and

WHEREAS, the ONDCP has sent a letter stating their intent to provide H.I.D.T.A FY17 grant funds to the Denver Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent to fund, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 16-0467;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Public Safety Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 12000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
