Business, Workforce & Sustainability

BR12- 0958 Amends the Kennel Facility Lease with the United States of America for janitorial services for \$7,398 to be paid to the City annually to cover the cost of services (201206160-01).

Health, Safety, Education & Services

BR12- 0967 Approves a contract with Denver Options, Inc., doing business as Rocky Mountain Human Services in the amount of \$10,989,504 to be paid from the dedicated mill levy revenues for the purpose of providing services to Denver residents with developmental disabilities (SOCSV 201209022).

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

RR12- 0972 Grants a revocable permit to Friedman Kentro, LLC, to encroach into the public right-of-way with storm sewer pipe in the alley at 750 Colorado Blvd. in Council District 5.

RR12- 0973 Grants a revocable permit to Coughlin and Company, Inc., to encroach into the public right-of-way with steps, a ramp, railing and stairs at 1550 Wynkoop in Council District 9.

RR12- 0974 Grants a revocable permit to Greenbox II, LLC, to encroach into the public right-of-way with a secure fence, a parking lot and storage area at 2424 Delgany in Council District 9.

RR12- 0975 Grants a revocable permit to Colorado Coalition for the Homeless to encroach into the public right-of-way with two permanent storm manholes and gravity pipe at 22nd and Stout streets in Council District 8.

BR12- Amends a contract with Jacobs Project Management to extend the term

0968 from June 1, 2013 to Dec. 31, 2013, with no additional cost, to complete various projects (CE85030-3).

BR12-0969 Amends a contract with Jacobs Project Management to extend the term from Dec. 31, 2012 to Dec. 31, 2013, with no additional cost, to provide continuing project management services and support at the Smith Road Campus (CE65010-2).

BR12-0970 Approves a contract with Denver Bike Sharing to expend state and federal funding for purchase and installation of 27 new B-Cycle stations with 150 bikes (201207075; 201207074).

BR12-0971 Vacates 50 feet of Ames St. between West 10th Ave. and the north line of Runyan's Subdivision as part of the RTD West Rail Line in Council District 3.
