Scope of work:

Temporary installation of art, placemaking elements, and installation of solar lighting at the Tennessee Utility Corridor.

Was this contractor selected by competitive process? No **If not, why not?** APNA started working directly with Xcel Energy, the property owner, in 2018 in install short-term temporary park like improvements along the corridor. In October of 2018 APNA secured a grant from the Colorado Health Foundation to install these improvements. In late 2018 Denver Parks and Recreation was brought into the discussion and has worked over the past three years with Xcel and Denver’s DOTI to formalize a License Agreement between the City and Xcel to install and maintain a permanent concrete trail and other park improvements along the corridor. A requirement of this License Agreement was that The City and County of Denver enter into a sublicense agreement with the local Registered Neighborhood Organization for installation, ownership, and maintenance of the temporary art installations. APNA is responsible for installing and all maintenance the art installation. In this case, the project site is located within Athmar Park Neighborhood and APNA is the logical and most fit Registered Neighborhood Organization for this scope of work.
