A BILL

For an ordinance relinquishing the easements, in their entirety, 1) reserved in Ordinance No. 307, Series of 1969, recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Book 83, Page 269; and 2) reserved in Ordinance No. 20, Series of 1923, recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Book 4899, Page 472, located at 123 Speer Boulevard

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure of the City and County of Denver has found and determined that the public use, convenience and necessity no longer requires the easements in the above-referenced Ordinances, and subject to approval by ordinance, has relinquished the same;

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the action of the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure in relinquishing the easements reserved in Ordinance No. 307, Series of 1969, recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Book 83, Page 269; and reserved in Ordinance No. 20, Series of 1923, recorded with the Denver Clerk & Recorder at Book 4899, Page 472, be and the same is hereby approved and that the easements in the above-described Ordinance are hereby relinquished.
