

## PROCLAMATION NO. 20-1016 RECOGNIZING THE EXTRAORDINARY CAREER AND RETIREMENT OF KARIN HOWSHAR

**WHEREAS**, a Recreation Supervisor must be a "jack-of-all-trades", great with the public, highly engaged and capable of leading teams. Karin loved being with the public and supporting events important to the community such as the annual Peace March in the Cole neighborhood; and

**WHEREAS,** Karin's passion for pickleball enabled her to support the popular Annual Pickleball Blast since its inauguration in 2015; and

WHEREAS, Karin advocated for the success of youth who were dedicated to the St. Charles Recreation Center, proudly and enthusiastically involving herself in the St. Charles Place Park Project and youth ambassadors group with whom she worked for many years in the recreation center, serving as a mentor and positive role model.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:
