The Denver Office of Climate Action, Sustainability and Resiliency (CASR) is transferring 2025 funding from their Electrified Mobility Improvements capital program to their Electrified Mobility Maintenance capital program. During the course of 2024 and after the 2025 budget year appropriation request was made, CASR has taken responsibility for the maintenance and repair of fleet charging stations. Many of these stations had not been maintained or repaired by the previous managing agency, inconsistent with the needs of a rapidly electrifying fleet. CASR has the specialized personnel, skill, and contracting partners to provide this service to our partner agencies, with a level of service that is not possible otherwise. CASR seeks to do this from previously appropriated capital funds and not from funds remaining in the Climate Protection Special Revenue Fund.
