 - a. Scope of Work

Denver Parks and Recreation has negotiated an agreement with the non-profit Colorado Miners to administer programs for youth at the transitional center at Johnson.

Denver Parks and Recreation will partner with Colorado Miners to provide programming for youth in the Elyeria Swansea neighborhood. Colorado Miners will provide sports and youth mentoring programs.

The benefit to the City is that Johnson Recreation center was identified in 2010 as a transition center and the City is looking to partner with non-profits to continue to provide services to the community.
