**Denver Parks and Recreation has negotiated an agreement with the non-profit Colorado Miners to administer programs for youth at the transitional center at Johnson .**

**Denver Parks and Recreation will partner with Colorado Miners to provide programming for youth in the Elyeria Swansea neighborhood. Colorado Miners will provide sports and youth mentoring programs.**

**The benefit to the City is that Johnson Recreation center was identified in 2010 as a transition center and the City is looking to partner with non-profits to continue to provide services to the community.**
