Attach executive summary if more space needed:** Purchase Order PO-00184816 is for the 2026 capital replacement and procurement of one Chevrolet Suburban for Airfield Emergency Operations, three Chevrolet Tahoe's Police Traffic Units with standardized upfits, and five additional Chevrolet Silverado's Police Pursuit Vehicles with standardized upfits for Denver Police Department at Denver International Airport on the 2026 long bill. These are replacing 4 existing units that have reached the end of their life cycle and adding 5 additional Patrol units to the Denver Police Fleet. These units are an integral part of the safety and security of our airport operations.

This request supports Denver International Airport's Vision 100: Maintaining What We Have and Growing our Infrastructure. Replacement of aging assets reduces downtime to the Operations and Denver Police groups while ensuring aging assets are replaced to prevent unnecessary repair time and costs to depreciate end of life assets. We are also expanding our Police Fleet at DEN due to the increase of passenger and business volume per prior Council approval of the 2026 Fleet Capital Budget.
