a. Scope of Work

This contract will provide Technical support and services for the Airport Noise and Operations Monitoring System (ANOMS). A non-competitive selection process is requested as the ANOMS system is proprietary and cannot be serviced by third parties. We are currently evaluating competing noise monitoring systems for potential replacement, but no viable alternative will be available for review until at least mid-2013. Until other monitoring systems become available, Bruel & Kjaer has no competitors in their market.
