7 **For an ordinance submitting to a vote of the qualified and registered electors of**
8 **the City and County of Denver at a special municipal election to be held in**
9 **conjunction with the regular biennial school board election of November 1, 2011,**
10 **a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City and County of Denver**

12 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

13 **Section 1.** There is hereby submitted to the properly qualified and registered electors of the
14 City and County of Denver for their approval or rejection at a special municipal election to be
15 conducted at the same time and in conjunction with the regular biennial school board election to be
16 held in the City and County of Denver on November 1, 2011, a proposed amendment to the
17 Charter of the City and County of Denver, as follows:

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19 **Effective upon publication and filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to the**
20 **Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, the following subsection G shall be**
21 **added to section 5.2.1 of the Charter of the City and County of Denver:**

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23 **“(G) *Appointment of Deputy.*** The Auditor may appoint a Deputy, who shall in addition to any other
24 duties assigned perform such functions and exercise such powers of the Auditor as the Auditor may
25 specifically assign to such Deputy.”

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27 **Section 2.** The voting machines and paper ballot for said election shall carry the following
28 designation, which shall be the title and submission clause:

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32 **REFERRED QUESTION _____**

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“Shall the Charter of the City and County of Denver be amended to permit the Auditor to appoint a deputy to perform such duties as may be assigned by the Auditor?”

Section 3. Each elector voting at the election and wishing to for or against the amendment shall indicate the elector’s choice by depressing the appropriate counter of the voting machine which indicates the word “YES” or the word “NO”, or by appropriate marking upon paper ballots when used.

Section 4. The proper officials of the City and County of Denver as are charged with duties relating to the election shall, before the election, issue such calls, make such certifications and publications, give such notices, make such appointments, and do all such other acts and things in connection with the submission of this Charter amendment to the registered electors of the City and County of Denver at the election as are required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

Section 5. The ballots cast at such election shall be canvassed and the results ascertained, determined, and certified in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

Section 6. If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance shall not be affected.
