Government & Finance

BR12- Abolishes Career Service Authority jobs of 911 Lead Operator, 911 Operator, Aviation Tour Guide, Epidemiological Research Technician, Health Information Supervisor, Nuclear Medicine Technologist Supervisor, Nurse Midwife, Physician Assistant, Public Health Dentist and Senior Plus Case Coordinator; revises Community Rate Schedule A per state law and changes corresponding pay grades of Activities Leader I – Non Certified, Activities Leader II – Certified, Advanced Lifeguard, Fitness Instructor I – Non Certified, Fitness Instructor II – Certified, Lifeguard, Pool Supervisor, Sports Official I- Non Certified, Sports Official II – Certified and adds pay grade and job code of Television & Video Production Support Technician.

RR12- Approves the Mayoral appointment of Derrick Fuller to the Career Service Authority Board of Directors for a term effective immediately and expiring on September 16, 2014 or until a successor is duly appointed.

BR12- Approves a lease agreement allowing The Greenway Foundation to use

regarding the space, including meeting space, for office and
programming for a term ending Dec. 31, 2017, in Council District 7.

BR12- Amends the Intergovernmental agreement with School District 1

extend the term 3 years and to allow the City to offer compost to
certain sites.
