The City and County of Denver Office of the City Forester (OCF) is seeking qualified contractors for on-call contract services related to public tree inventory work throughout the City.

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose of these On-Call contracts is to establish and maintain a pool of qualified On-Call Tree Inventory Contractors available to respond to proposal bidding requests for the execution of the OCF 3-year, \$1.1 Million work plan.

Services include updating the existing public tree inventory utilizing Davey TreeKeeper software with any missing or removed trees, as well as current species, location, condition and detailed size information.

Procurement:

One (1) firm provided a qualification submittal which was reviewed and scored. That firm was selected to provide On-Call services.

Contracts Description:

The contract has a three (3) year term and a capacity of \$1.1 million. The firm selected for this agreement is: Davey Resource Group, Inc.

This contract does not commit funds, nor does it guarantee any amount to the firm. This contract is not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via task notices on an as needed basis.
