**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission in the General Fund, making appropriations in the General Fund and the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund, and authorizing expenditures in the General Government Special Revenue Fund, the Culture and Recreation Special Revenue Fund, and the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the General Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the General Fund:
