For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the General Government Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from United States of America to award funding for the "Head Start Grant FY 2011-12" program.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services awards Head Start funds to the City and County of Denver annually; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human Services has sent an award letter to the Mayor's Office stating their intent to provide Head Start FY2011-2012 funds for Denver's Great Kids Head Start Program; and

WHEREAS, the City's fiscal rules allow an appropriation of up to half the amount stated in an award letter of an established grant program, based on a letter of intent to fund; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said award letter, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 11-353;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the General Government Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 11000, the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

The foregoing authorization will provide services (education, nutrition, health, mental health, disabilities and family services) to 1,083 children ages 3-5. Authorization for expenditures will cover the period from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012.
