**A BILL**

**For an ordinance making a rescission from and an appropriation in the General Fund, making cash transfers from the General Fund and Special Revenue Funds, and making appropriations in the Public Art Capital Program Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to move 2022 savings from Council District Four’s General Fund operating budget to Denver Arts and Venues to the City’s Public Art Program for the Bible Park Playground; and

**WHEREAS**, per the City’s Public Art Ordinance, the City needs to transfer cash from the Solution Center Special Revenue Fund to the Public Art Program Fund for the Public Art contribution requirement prior to closing the Solution Center Special Revenue Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to transfer cash from the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund to the Public Art Program Fund for insurance proceeds that were received for the Burns Park fine arts loss;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the General Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the General Fund:
