Brief Biography

Alex Markovich is a licensed architect and community-builder whose work spans design, policy, and civic engagement. He earned his Master of Architecture from the University of Colorado Denver, where studio projects often involved collaboration with Denver's cultural and creative community. Professionally, his built work includes sports, recreation, entertainment venues, affordable housing, and urban mixed-use projects. Some highlights include Casa Bonita, the Standard at Boulder, the Arvada Beer Garden, an NHL training facility, and helping launch a Denver-focused international design competition. His policy work revolves around housing affordability, smart stair reform, gentle density zoning, and regenerative design more broadly.

Alex maintains an active painting and printmaking practice, and loves connecting with Denver's arts community through workshops, classes, and events—especially at the Art Students League of Denver. He serves the Democratic party of Denver as Chair of the Platform and Resolutions Committee, holds a leadership role on the AIA Colorado Government Affairs Committee, and also serves on the Executive Committee at JEWISHcolorado. Before his pivot to architecture, Alex worked at Mile High United Way where he managed information systems.
