



Historic District for Preservation

Overview

- Applicants: Elizabeth Cito, John Hayden, Thomas Iseman, Rich Maginn, Joel Noble, Pat Romero, Kathy Struble, and William A. West
- District meets criteria: History 1A, Architecture 2A and Geography 3B & 3C.
- Application is complete
- December 7, 2010 LPC voted to move the application to a public hearing
- January 5, 2011 Planning Board reviewed the application and voted unanimously to recommend approval of the proposed designation.
- **February 15, 2011** LPC moved that the designation be moved forward to City Council with a recommendation of approval.



Category – History

History – 1a have direct association with the historical development of the city state, or nation.

 Area developed as part of Denver's earliest streetcar suburb. The district directly reflects the growth and development of Denver during the later part of the 19th & early 20th centuries.




Category - Architecture

Architecture - 2A, embody distinguishing characteristics of an architectural style or type;

 Strong examples of Italianate, Queen Anne, and Denver Square. Unique examples of Richardsonian Romanesque and Second Empire Baroque.

Category - Geography

Geography — 3B, Promote understanding and appreciation of the urban environment by means of distinctive physical characteristics
