**A BILL**

**For an ordinance rescinding unspent budget from the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Projects Fund.**

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Revised Municipal Code requires that upon completion of a Capital Improvement Project, any remaining unexpended budget balance shall be closed and any unexpended appropriations shall be returned to the fund balance of the Capital Fund or Enterprise Fund from which the project originated; and

**WHEREAS**, for Capital Improvement Projects that were funded but never initiated, legislative approval is required to rescind budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Capital Planning and Programming Division in the Department of Finance identified two capital projects that were never initiated and are no longer necessary, with a combined budget of \$9,896,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the unspent funds will be returned to fund balance in the Capital Improvements and Maintenance Fund to support the Fund's financial position and has been appropriated as part of the 2022 annual budget;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** From appropriations heretofore made from the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund listed or indicated in the following tabulation there is hereby RESCINDED the amount listed or indicated in such tabulation under the heading "Amount Rescinded" and transferred to the Capital Improvements and Capital Maintenance Fund:
