Central Student Transportation will operate and provide transportation services for individuals experiencing homelessness. This includes the "circular route" that connects many congregate shelters with additional services. CST will support City of Denver cold weather sheltering operations transporting people from downtown service to cold weather shelter sites. Other transportation services as determined by HOST related to street outreach or housing efforts will also be provided.

Scope of work:

SERVICES DESCRIPTION

- A. CST will be responsible for adhering to the Program Standards document to be provided by HOST.
- B. CST will provide bus transportation to individuals experiencing homelessness Monday thru Friday (or as specified by HOST) through the term of this contract using transit buses.
- C. Service Area: Designated origin and end transit stops generally located within five (5) miles from central downtown Denver between 8:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. but may be expanded based on service coverage demands as determined by HOST. Starting locations are in central downtown Denver and ending locations are in the vicinity of I-70 and Colorado Boulevard.
- D. Primary transportation services include but are not limited to:
 1. A “Circular Route” to provide system-wide transportation services between Shelters.
 2. “Newcomers” transportations services as part of existing or emerging citywide responses.
 3. Inclement weather transportation services.
 4. Other transportation services as determined by HOST related to street outreach or housing efforts.
- E. Accessibility: CST will provide ADA accessible vehicles for individuals in wheelchairs or with other mobility impairments.
- F. Capacity: Transportation will allow for approximately 150 people during the time frames specified for the circular route and ridership demand for other services.
- G. Safety: All buses will have a camera and audio to monitor activities on the bus.
- H. CST must have a contingency plan that includes notification to HOST management, shelter locations and clientele if they cannot run routes and/or individual buses and if routes and/or individual buses are running late.
