CURRENT BOARD STATUS

Scope of Board/Commission: Working with residents, businesses, civic leaders, area developers, and financing institutions, DURA provides financial assistance to support redevelopment activities throughout the city. These include single family home rehabilitation, emergency home repair, historic preservation, brownfield redevelopment, infill development, and neighborhood revitalization, among others. DURA's programmatic activities are separated into two departments, Housing and Redevelopment.

Appointment Process: Mayor appoints 11 of the 13 Commissioners and City Council confirms for a term of 5 years. The other two commissioners are one elected board member of Denver Public Schools and one board member of a special district that levies a property tax within Denver.

Strategic outreach and communications specialist with experience convening task forces, assembling community groups and leading charettes to present ideas and garner stakeholder support. Formerly the Executive Director of Exercise & License, she was appointed by Mayor Michael Hancock to be a member of his Cabinet by leading the business regulatory agency for the City & County of Denver. Served as the first permanent local regulator in the country for retail marijuana and worked nationally on developing medical and retail marijuana policy and procedures. Worked with community groups, neighborhood associations & business industry groups to enhance the City's regulatory practices on issues ranging from taxis and food trucks to creating new liquor licenses that reflect changing desires for community amenities.
