a. Scope of Work

The proposed seventh amendment would allow the extension of the agreement for twelve (12) months through December 31, 2012; and, appropriate an additional \$204,500 bringing the total agreement amount to \$1,350,900.

No changes to the scope of work or fee schedule are proposed for 2012. Scope of work encompasses services for Denver Police Department (DPD), DPD Victim Assistance Unit, and the Denver Fire Department.
