Janice Sinden joined the Denver Center for the Performing Arts as President & CEO in 2016. Before the DCPA, she served as Chief of Staff for Denver Mayor Michael B. Hancock for more than five years where she managed 60 appointees, 26 departments and the day-to-day complexities that come with running a major metropolitan city.

Prior to joining the Hancock Administration, Janice served as the Executive Director of Colorado Concern, an alliance of top executives who promote a pro-business environment through the political process. Her career also includes lobbying at the Colorado State Capitol and advising on political campaigns, as well as serving as the Manager of Community Relations/Corporate Communications for Sharp HealthCare in San Diego. Her love for public service sparked when she moved to Washington, D.C. to work for then U.S. Senator Wayne Allard after graduating from college.

She currently serves on the boards of Citizens for Arts to Zoo, University of Northern Colorado, VISIT Denver, American Transplant Foundation and Denver Preschool Program. She is also a member of the Performing Arts Centers Consortium, Independent Presenters Network, Theatre Communications Group, National Western Stock Show and Colorado Concern. Previously, she was appointed by Governors Owens and Ritter to serve on the Colorado Creative Industries Council.
