The purpose of this Amendment is to extend the term of this Professional Design Services Agreement by two years, through September 30, 2023. Capacity of the contract will be increased from \$791,769.33 to \$1,191,631.97. Now that design of this bridge is nearing completion, this Amendment is needed to provide professional engineering and related services during construction of the replacement bridge which will carry W. 8th Ave. Bridge over the S. Platte River. The RFQ for this Contract stated that Professional Services during construction would eventually be requested from the selected firm.

Services include, but are not limited to, bridge engineering, surveying, hydraulic analysis, project management, geotechnical investigations, evaluation of environmental impacts, roadway and trail design and detours, utility coordination, and public involvement. The RFQ for this Contract stated that Professional Services during construction would eventually be requested from the selected firm.

Replace an 89-year-old bridge which has far exceeded its initial life expectancy. The bridge serves as an important transportation link to and from Interstate 25 for critical local truck access to nearby industrial uses.
