MLK Roadway Extension (Havana to Peoria) Funding Agreement between CCD and the Park Creek Metro District. The Funding Agreement allows CCD to pay PCMD to perform construction work on MLK that CCD has received federal funding for (through CDOT). PCMD will perform all design and construction of MLK and CCD will use federal funds to reimburse PCMD, subject to PCMD meeting all federal and local requirements. The Agreement also covers the use of Stapleton TIF and District “intract” non-TIF for this project.
