6 **For an ordinance making a rescission and a supplemental appropriation from**
7 **the General Fund Contingency to Human Rights and Community**
8 **Partnerships.**

10 **WHEREAS**, the Human Rights and Community Partnerships requires \$150,000 in additional
11 resources in 2019 to support the City’s contract with the Denver Immigrant Legal Service Fund of
12 the Denver Foundation to provide direct legal representation to immigrants;
