A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing a capital equipment purchase in the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE) is seeking approval for a capital equipment purchase of two vans to be used for Office of the Medical Examiner (OME) decedent transportation, an issue which has escalated to the point where an emergency purchase is being pursued; and

WHEREAS, the current vendor is unable to provide adequate service to OME and the residents of Denver; and

WHEREAS, no existing vendors or companies bid on the recent RFP to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, to perform this service in-house OME needs two all-wheel drive vans that can hold up to four decedents; and

WHEREAS, the vehicles will be purchased out of the Planned Fleet Special Revenue Fund, on behalf of DDPHE; and

WHEREAS, said vehicles are over the \$50,000 threshold for capital equipment items that require City Council approval, per the Denver Revised Municipal Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. From the Planned Fleet Fund, Accounting No. 11804, the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, or duly authorized representatives, is hereby authorized to purchase or acquire the following capital equipment:
