- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved**
 - a. Scope of Work**

The one-year extension and increased contract amount allows the City to continue remediation and groundwater monitoring activities at an existing City owned underground storage tank (UST) site. Work at the UST site is regulated and required by the State's Division of Oil and Public Safety. Additionally, the contracted company will provide investigation, remediation, and other environmental services to City departments as requested, such as may be associated with the sale of a property or preparing a plan to meet environmental requirements.
 - b. Duration**

The term will extend until October 29, 2014.
 - c. Location**

On-going remediation and monitoring of a UST site located at 5440 Roslyn. The contract also allows for investigation, remediation, and site restoration (as needed) of other properties that the City owns, may wish to purchase, or may wish to sell.
 - d. Affected Council District**

Denver District 11 per current UST work.
 - e. Benefits**

Meet the regulatory requirements of the State's Division of Oil and Public Safety, and protect public health and environment by implementing the required remediation actions.
 - f. Costs**

The original contract amount is \$480,000. The increase is \$500,000, for a total amount of \$980,000.
