This is the eighteenth year the Department of Environmental Health, Denver Office of HIV Resources (DOHR) Division has received Ryan White Part A funding from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services through the Health Resources & Services Administration. The amount, \$2,996,813.00, represents a partial award for FY 2011 from March 1, 2011 to February 29, 2012 for the grant application submitted to the federal government in September 2010 due to Congressional budget disputes.
