5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved

a. Scope of Work

Arts & Venues Denver has a number of food and beverage revenue contracts in the arenas division facilities (Red Rocks and Denver Coliseum) and the Crossroads Theatre and that are expiring in the coming year. In order to align the contract termination dates in anticipation of a bid process to renew these contracts, several amendments are required to align the termination dates to a common date of October 30, 2012.

The following amendment will serve to accomplish this goal.

- Amendment to Section 4 of Agreement, entitled "TERM" to read April 8, 2003 and continue through and including October 31, 2012.
- Amendment to Section 14, Subsection 14.A., entitled "GRANT" to add additional grant consideration of \$425,000.00, payable on January 16, 2012. Contractor will amortize the additional Grant funding of \$425,000.00 on a straight-line basis over the period commencing on the date of expenditure and terminating on October 31, 2012.
