A BILL

For an ordinance to appropriate funds from the RiNo General Improvement District for the Streetscape Enhancements along Brighton Boulevard.

WHEREAS, The City has received funding from the RiNo General Improvement District as established in Ordinance 16-0282 for the construction of the construction and maintenance of the Streetscape Enhancements along Brighton Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has identified the project to be funded;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:
