The proposed ordinance will accomplish two purposes: (1) authorize receipt of revenue under Charter 3.2.6(e), and (2) appropriate the fund/org/project ID.

This ordinance will approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Colorado Department of Transportation to allow the City to accept and expend Federal and State funds in the amount of \$1,380,000.00 for the design and construction of six (6) traffic signals. The scope of work will include new traffic poles, controllers and cabinets, conduits, signal and pedestrian displays, and traffic signs and striping. The intersections selected on this project were approved in the 2007-2012 DRCOG Tip program.
