A BILL

For an ordinance authorizing expenditures in the Public Health Special Revenue Fund based on a letter of intent from the United States Department of Health and Human Services to award funding to the City and County of Denver for the “Ryan White Part A” program for fiscal year 2025.

WHEREAS, the United States of America, Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA), has sent a letter of intent (LOI) to the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment stating their intent to provide Ryan White Part A FY25 Grant Program funds in the amount of \$5,194,960 for the 2025 program year; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said letter of intent, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 20240153;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Public Health Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 14000, the amount of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:
