6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

This grant agreement will provide funding for the implementation of the River Vision Implementation Plan (RVIP) to improve the regional trail, create and enhance habitat within the river and along its banks, increase recreational access and promote educational opportunities. This ordinance amends the IGA and appropriates an additional \$350,000 to be received from UDFCD for a total of \$1,600,000. These funds will be used for the implementation of the RVIP, specifically for improvements at the Vanderbilt Park, Johnson-Habitat Park, Grant Frontier/Overland Park to improve recreational and educational opportunities along the river corridor. This ordinance will set up a capital grant fund and appropriate the budget for this grant as follows:
