Attach executive summary if more space needed:  The proposed resolution authorizes a second amendment to the contract with Ernst & Young Infrastructure Advisors, LLC (EY). EY currently serves as infrastructure municipal financial advisor to the City, for non-airport financial obligations, pursuant to a contract that was originally initiated on April 1, 2022, and is now set to expire on March 31, 2025. This amendment will extend the contract for nine months and will add \$2,000,000 to the total contract amount.  EY was selected as infrastructure municipal financial advisor to the City as part of a competitive bid process. Due to the essential and satisfactory advisory services provided by EY, the specialized nature of these services, and the limited number of firms providing municipal financial advisory services with a local presence and experience in Denver, the Department of Finance is recommending an amendment to the contract for nine months and allow time for a full, comprehensive procurement of financial advisory services.  6.
