A BILL

For an ordinance designating certain property as “park” under section 2.4.5 of the city charter, namely Bayaud Park.

Whereas, the following real property, known as Bayaud Park, which is under the jurisdiction of the Denver Department of Parks and Recreation has been or will be used for park purposes within the City and County of Denver (“Park Property”):

Tracts L, N and P, Lowry Filing No. 1.

Whereas, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and the Manager of Parks and Recreation have recommended that said Park Property be formally designated as a “park” under section 2.4.5 of the City Charter.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Park Property, known as Bayaud Park, is hereby designated as a “park” under section 2.4.5 of the City Charter and shall henceforth be regarded as being a designated park in the City and County of Denver, the designation being subject to any existing utilities lawfully located in the Park Property as of the date of this park designation.
