Business, Workforce & Sustainability

- BR10-1071 Approves a second amendment to the HCA-HealthONE sponsorship agreement to extend the contract term through December 31, 2012, and to outline rights, benefits, and compensation to Theatres & Arenas (RC52011).

Government Affairs & Finance

- BR10-1065 Approves classifications for Budget Management Supervisor, Computer Operations Supervisor, Elevator Inspector, Hearings Reporter, Public Art Coordinator, and Secretarial Assistant to the Mayor's Office to be abolished.
- BR10-1077 Approves closing out various grant budgets and cash balances (\$2,088.23) to be rescinded and transferred to the General Fund.
- BR10-1078 Approves year-end adjustments to Public Works operating budgets by rescinding \$600,000 from Public Works Administration and Transportation funds and reappropriating same to the Public Works Operations fund.
- BR10-1084 Approves year-end adjustments to Safety operating budgets, including rescissions, reappropriations and a supplemental appropriation (\$1,040,000), most of which are covered by additional revenues.
- RR10-1066 Approves the annual City Property Tax Mill Levy upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the year 2010 to be collected in 2011 for purposes authorized by law.
- RR10-1067 Approves the School District 1 Mill Levies upon all taxable property within the City and County of Denver taxes for the year 2010 for purposes authorized by law for School District No. 1 in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

- RR10-1068 Approves the Special District Mill Levies upon all taxable property for the year 2010 within special districts within the City and County of Denver for purposes authorized by law for special districts.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- BR10-1061 Approves a contract with the Colorado Coalition for the Homeless from January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011 to provide \$934,631 for street outreach services to homeless persons in Denver.
- BR10-1064 Accepts \$750,000 in federal funding for the City's cross-agency work to respond to violence against women.
- BR10-1073 Approve an ordinance amending Section 18-164(e) of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, for pay differential for civilian and sworn personnel serving in Afghanistan and/or Iraq conflicts, extending the "sunset provision" of this Section to December 31, 2011.
- RR10-1076 A resolution approving a Council appointment to the Welfare Reform Board

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

- RR10-1070 Amends Resolution No. 79, Series of 2008, granting a revocable permit to The Vidette LLC to add the following encroachments in the right-of-way: 4 ADA handicap ramps, 1 set of stairs and 2 concrete pads for sculptural work at 3353 Larimer and 3300 Walnut in Council District 9. ROW #2010-0304-02.
- RR10-1072 Grants a revocable permit to Citigroup Property Investors to encroach into the right-of-way with a Marquee canopy, a bench attached to the building, art display, a totem sign, a steel bar canopy, and 1 sign at 1405 Curtis in Council District 8. ROW #1991-0073-01.
- RR10-1074 Dedicates existing City owned land as part of Amherst Ave. between S. Colorado Blvd. and S. Birch St. in Council District 4. ROW #2010-0470-01.
- RR10-1075 Dedicates existing City owned land as Yale Ave. between S. Colorado Blvd. and S. Clermont Dr., and at the intersection of Yale and S. Monaco in Council District 4. ROW #2010-0471-01.
- BR10-1062 Approves an increase in contract amount with Wenk Associates for additional professional services including surveying, structural engineering and on site storm water inspection (CE80115).
- BR10-1063 Approves a capital construction contract with B T Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$1,951,743.59 for the construction of 2010 General

Storm Drainage - Phase 1 (CE02068).
