6 **A RESOLUTION**

8 **Amending Resolution No. 0756, Series of 2019, concerning the "Cancer,
9 Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Disease" program.**

12 **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 0756, Series of 2019, accepted an amended grant agreement for
13 the Cancer, Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Disease Program with the State of Colorado to
14 increase the original award amount of \$427,441 by \$590,009 for a new total of \$1,017,450; and

15 **WHEREAS**, said grant is part of the Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Program, which was
16 administered by the Department of Public Health and Environment (DDPHE) in 2019; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Resolution therefore identified a DDPHE fund and cost center for the grant
18 appropriation account, and identified DDPHE as the expending authority; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the SRTS program, which is part of Denver’s Vision Zero initiative, was moved to
20 the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure to better align resources and strategies with
21 the appropriate department;

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY
24 OF DENVER:**

26 **Section 1.** That Section 2 of Resolution No. 0756, Series of 2019, now reads:

27 “The payments made by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment to the
28 City pursuant to and under the amended Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of
29 the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is set forth and described in
30 Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.”

32 **Section 2.** That Section 3 of Resolution No. 0756, Series of 2019, now reads:

33 “That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to
34 be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure is as
35 follows:
