A BILL

For an ordinance submitting to a vote of the qualified and registered electors of the City and County of Denver at the general municipal election on April 4, 2023, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City and County of Denver concerning the City Council's zoning authority under Charter Sec. 3.2.9.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. There is hereby submitted to the properly qualified and registered electors of the City and County of Denver for their approval or rejection at a special municipal election to be conducted at the same time and in conjunction with the general municipal election to be held in the City and County of Denver on April 4, 2023 a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City and County of Denver, as follows:

Effective upon publication and filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, the following sections of the Charter of the City and County of Denver are amended to read as follows:

§ 3.2.9 - Zoning.

(B) Zone ~~D~~districts. For any or all of said purposes, the Council may divide the City and County of Denver into ~~Districts~~ zone districts of such manner, shape and area as may be deemed best suited to carry out the purposes of this Charter; and within such zone districts it may regulate and restrict the erection, construction, reconstruction, alteration, repair or use of buildings, structures or land. All such regulations shall be uniform for each class or kind of buildings throughout each zone district, but the regulations in one ~~District~~ zone district may differ from those in other ~~Districts~~ zone districts.

(D) *Method of procedure*. The Council shall provide for the manner in which such zoning regulations and restrictions and the boundaries of such zone districts shall be determined,

established and enforced, and from time to time amended, supplemented or changed. However, no such zoning regulation, restriction or boundary shall become effective until after a public hearing in relation thereto, at which parties in interest and citizens shall have an opportunity to be heard. At least fifteen days' notice of the time and place of such hearing shall be published in an official publication in the City and County of Denver.

(E) *Changes.* Such zoning regulations, restrictions and boundaries may from time to time be amended, supplemented, changed, modified or repealed. In case, however, of a protest against such change, signed by the owners of property constituting at least twenty per-cent or more, either of:

(1) ~~‡~~The area of the lots included in such proposed change; or

(2) ~~‡~~The area ~~to a distance of~~ located within the City and County of Denver and within two hundred feet from the perimeter of the area proposed for change;

~~§~~Such amendment shall not become effective except by the favorable vote of ten of the members of the Council of the City and County of Denver. The provisions of the previous Section relative to public hearings and official notice shall apply equally to all changes or amendments.

Section 2. The ballot shall contain the following title and submission clause:

REFERRED QUESTION _____

Shall the Charter of the City and County of Denver be amended to clarify City Council's zoning authority and to require that zoning protests can only be initiated by residents of Denver?

Section 3. The proper officials of the City and County of Denver as are charged with duties relating to the election shall, before the election, issue such calls, make such certifications and publications, give such notices, make such appointments, and do all such other acts and things in connection with the submission of this Charter amendment to the registered electors of the City and County of Denver at the election as are required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

Section 4. The ballots cast at such election shall be canvassed and the results ascertained, determined, and certified in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to

1 be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance
2 shall not be affected.
