Monies received from assistance incentives or other sources of receipts shall be 20 deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 13000, which is set forth 21 and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver. 22 **Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Assistance Incentives Program" fund, 23 Accounting No. 13811-5510000, in the amount not to exceed the total of deposits described in 24 Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Manager of Human Services. Authorized

expenditures will include, but shall not be limited to personnel, training, equipment, travel, supplies

and reimbursable personnel expenditures for the purpose of supporting activities associated with

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Medicaid and other assistance programs.
