- 6. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
 - a. Scope of Work

This request is for the purchase of two hundred and seventy-nine (279) Cyber Country Systems, LLC (CCS) access control panels and associated hardware. DIA currently uses CCS panels in the airport's Security Access Control System, and they have provided exceptional reliability and functionality. This assessment is supported by an independent review that was conducted by Ross and Baruzzini, a security systems consultant, in 2012. The purchase of these panels will allow DIA to upgrade the Security Access Control System to include voice-over internet protocol audio and video capture capabilities without making changes to the overall system hardware and software.

The airport's entire Security Access Control System was built and is supported by CCS and the use of their panels is critical to the continuity of security operations and compliance. The panels include features that are not available from any other commercially produced security access control panel.

The total cost of the requested Purchase Order will exceed \$1Million. Funding is provided in the airport's Capital Plan.
