**A BILL**

**For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the Grant and Other Money Projects Series for the “Capital Improvement Claims Settlement” program.**

**WHEREAS**, the City recently won a subrogation claim against Union Pacific related to damage to a City bridge caused by Union Pacific’s negligence; and

**WHEREAS**, said claim return was deposited back to the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund which is the centralized location to administer activity related to subrogation, and

**WHEREAS**, companion ordinance 0101, series of 2024 transfers and appropriates the claim return into a Capital Project Fund to be used toward bridge repairs at the location where the damage occurred; and

**WHEREAS**, the City requires a new Capital Project Fund for this purpose;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the Grant and Other Money Projects Fund, Accounting No. 38000, “Capital Improvement Claims Settlement” Fund, Accounting No. 38434, to support the receipt of funds from the Risk Management Special Revenue Fund to be used for capital expenditures.

**Section 2.** Monies received from capital claims settlements shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.


**Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Capital Improvement Claims Settlement” Fund, Accounting No. 38434, to be expended by the Chief Financial Officer. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 38434 include capital projects and capital improvements. This is a revenue-based, non-lapsing fund.

1       **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary  
3 to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
