Government & Finance

BR13- Expends up to \$4,581,682 for renewal of the City's property and liability
0529 insurance coverage through contracts with Marsh USA (CE02088-04), Willis (201204716-01), and Aon (201204715-01) for policies due September 1, 2013.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

BR13- Accepts the 2013-2014 Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) in the
0528 amount of \$1,160,046.04 issued by the State of Colorado - Department of Local Affairs (2013-12202).

BR13- Permits the Denver Fire Department to execute a Non-Financial
0530 Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the Community College of Aurora Foundation for the donation of surplus City property (driving simulator) to enhance training for students enrolled in emergency medical services, firefighting, and law enforcement programs.

BR13- Amends the contract with Keefe to add a one year no-cost extension
0531 from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014 for inmate commissary services for the Denver Sheriff Department. The Inmate Welfare Fund receives approximately \$400,000 in annual commission from this contract which is used to fund inmate welfare and recreation items (RC63008-6).

BR13- Approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with West Metro Fire
0532 Department to allow them to use Denver vehicles that are marked for recycling for training purposes. The Denver Fire Department needs will be met first and any revenue generated from vehicle recycling will be credited to the City and County of Denver (201311660).

RR13- Approves the Mayoral appointment of Dana Rinderknecht to the Denver
0526 Office of Strategic Partnerships Commission for a term effective

immediately and expiring April 20, 2015 or until a successor is duly appointed.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

BR13-0533 Vacates portions of the alleys in the three blocks bounded by S. Lincoln and S. Sherman south of E. Mississippi and north of E. Arizona, with reservation, in Council District 7.

BR13-0534 Vacates a portion of the alley in the block bounded by W. 19th Ave, W. 18th Ave, N. Grove and N. Hooker in Kittredge's Resubdivision of Block 11, Cheltenham Heights near 3120 W. 19th Ave, with reservations, in Council District 1.

BR13-0538 Relinquishes certain easements established in 2012 at 1440 W. 33rd Ave. in Council District 9.

BR13-0539 Approves a Supplement to the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Regional Transportation District and Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to delineate responsibilities and cost sharing for maintenance of the 20th Street High Occupancy Vehicle structure from Wynkoop to I-25, which will be managed and maintained as part of CDOT's High Performance Transportation Enterprise, reducing the City's responsibilities and costs.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
