Executive Summary

This resolution approves a grant agreement with the U.S Department of Commerce's Economic Development Administration (EDA) awarding the City and County of Denver, specifically Denver Economic Development and Opportunity (DEDO), with \$750,000 in Build to Scale grant funds to support the Inclusive Impact Catalyst (IIC) program. IIC will focus on supporting early-stage, tech-industry entrepreneurs seeking training and coaching to position their businesses to be ready to acquire outside investment capital. This \$750,000 EDA Grant has a 1:1 match requirement. DEDO will be providing the match by utilizing America Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds which was approved by EDA and the City of Denver's Department of Finance (DoF).

DEDO is particularly interested in supporting entrepreneurs who are Black, Indigenous and people of color (BIPOC+), women, people with disabilities, veterans, foreign-born, and people who identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender or queer. After completion of a pre-program assessment and preparation of an individualized plan, IIC will prepare BIPOC+owned businesses to be capitalized through culturally aware executive coaching, mentorship, community-based events, educational workshops, and relevant resources and connections. This ecosystem will also address companies' readiness for capitalization related to gaps in their finance and accounting systems, business plan development, legal services, human resources, and marketing.

DEDO is preparing a request for proposals (RFP) to solicit and contract the services of one (1) contractor who will, in turn, solicit and subcontract the services of one or more subject matter specialists in an array of investment support services. DEDO anticipates releasing the RFP in June of 2024, with intentions of executing an agreement with the selected contractor by October 2024. The program is anticipated to reach 450 tech industry, Denver-based businesses and aspires to achieve outcomes of increased business valuation and job creation/retention for businesses successfully completing the program.
