16 and Infrastructure in relinquishing of the easement, in its entirety, reserved in Ordinance No.  
17 20220141, Series of 2022, recorded with Denver Clerk & Recorder at Reception No. 2022024413,  
18 be and the same is hereby approved and that the easement in the above-described Ordinance is  
19 hereby relinquished.
